Here's a great replacement for disease-prone redbtip photinia. The leaves of LeAnn™ cleyera emerge beautiful maroon in spring, change to dark green in summer, and then turn maroon again in fall and winter! This trouble-free evergreen grows 10 to 12 feet tall by 6 to 7 feet wide and likes sun or shade. It makes a great medium-size hedge or screen and rarely gets ugly leaf spot.
