A must for any traditional Southern garden, 'Ellen Bosanquet' Crinum offers burgundy flowers during the hottest summer months. Blooms are usually triggered after a good rain. Foliage can be a little messy but maintains a nice appearance with a little shade. Perhaps one of the most adapted crinums for many regions throughout the South and a must for any traditional Southern garden.

Key Feature	Blooms 2-3 times starting mid-summer. 11 or more trumpet shaped, dark pink blooms on solid stalks.
USDA Zones	Hardy to 0°F USDA zones 7-10
Exposure	Full sun to part shade
Dimension	12-24" tall x clumping
Growth Rate	Moderate to fast growth

Soil Type	Any
Fertilizer	Mix in low amount of an even n-p-k before planting
