

'Alabama Sunrise'

HEUCHERELLA

X Heucherella 'Alabama Sunrise' PP19611

The deeply cut foliage of 'Alabama Sunrise' changes color with the seasons. Bright gold, red-veined leaves become greener but hold that brilliant red flash; in fall, the older leaves develop coral tones. Humidity tolerant, too.

USE

Container, mass planting, border

BLOOM / BLOOM TIME

Small white flowers late spring to early summer

GROWTH RATE

Moderate in sun, slow in shade

WATER

Regular water

SOIL

Any well-drained soil

FERTILIZE

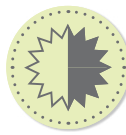
Monthly in gardens; bi-monthly in containers

PRUNE

Remove dead leaves during growing season and old growth at end of flowering season (late summer); deadhead old blooms at stalk base to lengthen flowering season
