HEUCHERELLA

X Heucherella 'Tapestry'

The dark-centered leaves are colored blue green in spring and summer and change to green with dark centers in fall and winter. New leaves have blue iridescence. Spring brings free flowering stems of warm pink flowers. Grows great in the South as well as the Northwest.

USE

Container, mass planting, border

BLOOM / BLOOM TIME

Small white flowers spring and summer

GROWTH RATE

Moderate in sun, slow in shade

WATER

Regular water

SOIL

Any well-drained soil

FERTILIZE

Monthly in gardens; bi-monthly in containers

PRUNE

Remove dead leaves during growing season and old growth at end of flowering season (late summer); deadhead old blooms at stalk base to lengthen flowering season
