SALVIA

Salvia microphylla 'Killer Cranberry' PPAF

Masses of magenta flowers on tall spikes lure honeybees and hummingbirds. Its prolific flowers are a killer attraction for people too. Dense, fragrant foliage, long-blooming and drought resistant.

USE

Perennial, Borders, Garden Beds, Containers

BLOOM / BLOOM TIME

Rich red flowers early spring to late fall

GROWTH RATE

Fast in spring and summer

WATER

Low water once established

SOIL

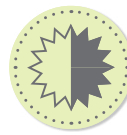
Well drained soils

FERTILIZE

Apply a balanced slow-release each spring and summer

PRUNE

Can cut back by 1/3 after first flower to keep compact



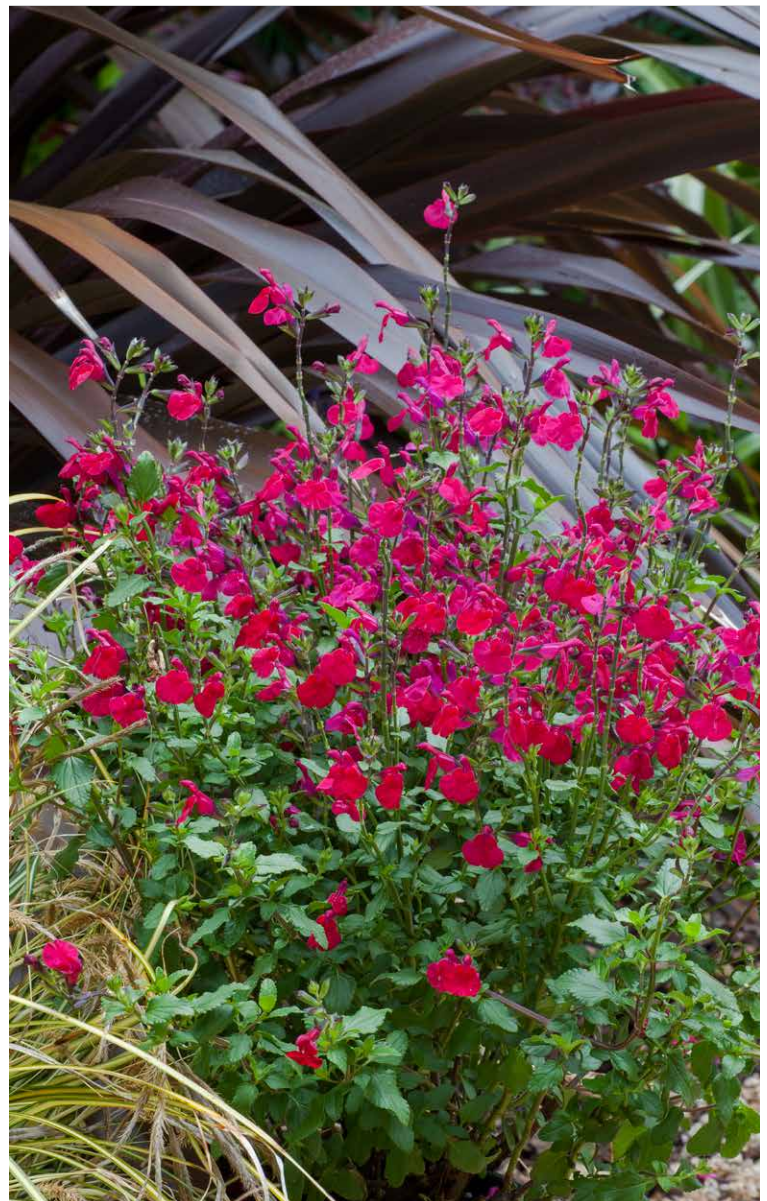
FULL SUN
