## CRAPEMYRTLE

*Lagerstroemia hybrid 'JD818' PP22697*

Early Bird Crapemyrtles begin blooming as early as Mother's Day, much earlier than other summer-blooming crapemyrtles, then rebloom for 100-120 days of color.

### USE

Accent, hedge, container

### BLOOM / BLOOM TIME

Lavender blooms through summer and fall

### GROWTH RATE

Moderate to fast

### WATER

Water as needed

### SOIL

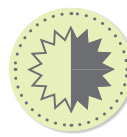
Rich, acidic, moist, well-drained soil

### FERTILIZE

Early spring

### PRUNE

Shape after spring bloom
