Gardenia jasminoides 'Leetwo' PPAF



KEY FEATURES

- Fragrant single white blossoms
- Reblooming spring to fall
- Enjoy intoxicating early blooms against dark evergreen foliage

PROPAGATION

- **Time of Year:** May–fall
- **Type of Wood:** Semi-hardwood cuttings
- **Hormone Used:** IBA 2500
- **Rooting Time:** 60 days; med–fast

GROWING/PLANTING FROM LINERS

Media:

- Regular ornamental mix
- **Soil/Bark:** 60% new screened bark and 40% aged screened bark
- **Lime:** Pulverized dolomitic 5 lbs per cubic yard
- **Talstar (Fire Ant Control):** 3.5 lbs per cubic yard

Media pH: 5.5 – 6.0

Media EC: 1.5 – 2.0

Exposure: Full sun to part shade

Finishing Time:

- **1 gallon:** Plant liner in early spring, and will finish that fall

- **2 gallon:** Plant liner in early spring, and will finish that fall and following spring
- **3 gallon:** Plant liner in late summer to early fall, and will finish the following fall
- Shifting up: A.) 1 gallon to 3 gallon planted in late summer, fall or winter will finish the following spring or fall

Moisture: Consistent, well-drained soil

Fertilizer: Slow release fertilizer

- Harrell's 18-5-13 OR
- Osmocote 15-9-11 OR
- Nutricote 18-8-8

Common Pests: White fly, Mealybug, aphids, spider mites, thrips in flowers, phytophthora root and crown rot

Trimming: After spring bloom

Light: Full sun to part shade

Mature Size: 2.5-3' H x 2.5-3' W

USDA Hardiness: Zones 7-10

Uses: Accent, Container, Cut flowers, Mass planting
