GROWING/PLANTING FROM LINERS

Media:

- Regular ornamental soil mix

Lime:

- Pulverized dolomitic 5 lbs per cubic yard
- Tissue culture liners available

Media pH: 5.5 – 6.5

Media EC: 2.0 – 3.0

Exposure: Full sun to part shade

Finishing Time:

- Spring planting is saleable following fall and spring
- Fall planting (greenhouse) is saleable the following spring
- TC liners result in healthy uniform crops

Moisture: Consistent, well-drained soil

Fertilizer: Slow release fertilizer

- Harrell's 18-5-13 OR
- Osmocote 15-9-11 OR
- Nutricote 18-8-8

Common Pests: White fly, aphids, spider mites, thrips, cercospora leaf spot, rhizoctonia web blight, xanthomonas spp. bacteria, and root rot if kept too wet

Trimming: None
