Tara™ Hydrangea

Hydrangea quericifolia 'Biv01'

KEY FEATURES

- Large white panicles
- Spring bloom
- Fall foliage color

PROPAGATION

- **Time of Year:** Early spring
- **Type of Wood:** Semi-hardwood cuttings
- **Hormone Used:** None
- **Rooting Time:** 30–45 days

GROWING/PLANTING FROM LINERS

Media:

- Regular ornamental soil mix
- Soil / Bark 60% new screen bark and 40% aged screen bark
- Lime: 5 lbs per cubic yard
- Talstar (Fire Ant Control): 3.5 lbs (check your soil bark density)

Media pH: 5.5–6.0

Media EC: 1.5–2.0

Exposure: Full sun to part shade

Finishing Time:

- 2–3 gallon: plant liner (1–2 per pot) Aug/Sep finish 1 year later
- May need to space into shade; heat may stress plant

Moisture: Consistent / water only when needed

Fertilizer: Slow release fertilizer

- Harrell's 18-5-13 OR
- Osmocote 15-9-11 OR
- Nutricote 18-8-8

Common Pests: Flea beetles, cercospora and rhizoctonia

Trimming: Light shaping

Light: Full sun to part shade

Mature Size: 6' H x 6' W

USDA Hardiness: 5–9

Uses: Accent, Container, Cut Flowers, Hedge, Mass Planting, Woodland Garden
