





This petite beauty displays dark purple foliage year-round and bursts with lovely dark pink to red string clusters each spring. Purple DaydreamTM is versatile, handling full sun to part shade, as well as offering drought tolerance and deer resistance. A compact loropetalum, it spreads nicely into a mound reaching 2–3 feet high by 3–4 feet wide.

Container, Hedge, Mass Planting, Slope
