USE

Accent, container, mass planting, border

BLOOM / BLOOM TIME

Scarlet red flower spikes April through November

GROWTH RATE

Fast

WATER

Regular water

SOIL

Any well-drained soil

FERTILIZE

Apply a balanced slow release each spring

PRUNE

Not required; dead-heading promotes new growth
